What is Demola ?

Demola is an industry-government-academia collaboration innovation creation platform provided by DEMOLA GLOBAL (Finland). It is an international corporate problem-solving network in which 60 universities from 16 countries around the world participate, and it is characterized by the fact that university / graduate students and companies working together to solve real company problems. Hokkaido University is operating for the first time in Japan. To date, a team of students has worked on "tasks" provided by more than 900 participating companies, and many ideas have been generated.

If a company likes an idea created by a student team, it receives a license from the student team to use the idea and leads to commercialization.

Graduate School Common Subjects : 「Corporate Problem Solving Exercise I / II」

General Education Exercises : 「Let's work together to solve the problems faced by companies! I / II」

This program aims to practically learn and acquire the thinking and behavioral approaches of entrepreneurship / intreprenurship. Students will take a two-month open innovation workshop and, as part of a team of students and business personnel, will build a model for solving the problems faced by the company. If the company submitting the assignment likes the idea, it may lead to a license agreement.

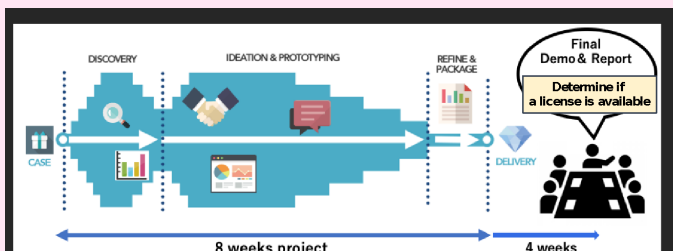

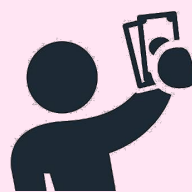
The Demola process
